Discipline Plan

We use our words to help ourselves and each other.

Rewards:

- Praise and cheers
- Stickers and stamps
- Menehune Award
- Phone calls/emails/notes home

Consequences:

- Verbal warning and redirection
- Time Out until child is ready to rejoin the class and debriefing (discussion of reason for time out). Time Outs are age appropriate to 1 minute for each year of child's age. Example: 4 year olds will spend 4 minutes in time out.
- Teacher advises parents of student's behavior.

Prior to the consequences taking place, the child is redirected to appropriate behaviors or given choices of other ways to display emotions. If behaviors persist, consequences will be enforced.

If a child is intentionally hurting others, they will be sent to the office. An office referral form will be found in the child's folder.

Before a child is allowed to leave time out, a debriefing between the child and teacher takes place. In this session, alternative behaviors are discussed and are agreed upon to try again.
